

## WEB notice of Taxes Due January 31, 2009

Property values for the Hamlin ISD are determined by Jones County Appraisal District, Fisher County Appraisal District or the Stonewall County Appraisal District, depending upon the respective county in which the property resides.

The Hamlin ISD tax rate is \$ 1.395.

Maintenance and Operations portion of tax rate:	\$1.17
I & S portion of tax rate:	\$ .225

### Timely Payment of Property Taxes

Property taxes are due upon receipt. You have from October 1, 2008 through January 31, 2009 to pay current 2008 year taxes without penalty or interest. Unpaid 2008 taxes become delinquent on February 1, 2009. Penalty and interest are added to the original base amount and continue to increase until they are paid.

By law, the Tax Assessor-Collector cannot waive penalty and interest on delinquent taxes, adjust, or ignore deadlines established in the Texas Property Tax Code.

### Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Homestead/Over 65/Disability Exemptions

A: Contact the Appraisal District in which your property resides to obtain directions on obtaining an exemption.

Q: I didn't get a tax bill, why do I have to pay penalty and interest?

A: As a property owner, you are responsible for making sure that the taxes are paid on time. The statements are mailed and taxes are due at the same time each year. If you have not received a bill, you may contact the Appraisal office and request one.
